I Appreciate everything everyone has done to help me over my journey, From F.O.E. State Outside Guard to the F.O.E State President.

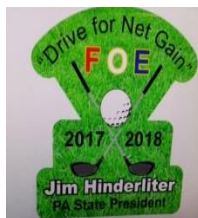
I Would like to give a Special Thanks to Bob Wahls And Larry Mendenhall (the Teach) for installing all of our new State Officers. Congratulations to you all.
