## MESSAGE FROM THE GRAND AERIE

Brothers & Sisters,

The last few weeks have been unlike any we have seen before due to the coronavirus crisis and as we continue to abide by the orders of our respective States and Provinces, we know that many of you have important questions about operations moving forward.

One of the primary concerns is in regard to local Aerie and Auxiliary Elections. Per the Grand Aerie Constitution & Statutes, Nominations are to be held annually at the last meeting in April. Obviously, this will not be possible for the majority of our Aeries and Auxiliaries this year.

Those that are still able to meet must proceed as outlined in the Constitution & Statutes. Those that cannot meet, by order of the Grand Worthy President, should proceed in the following manner:

- First meeting after re-opening: Nomination of Officers
- Second meeting after re-opening: Election of Officers
- At least 5 days after Elections: Installation of Officers

In the event a local Aerie or Auxiliary would like to expedite this process, they may do so only by following the Constitutional requirements regarding holding a Special Meeting, found in Section 72.2.

The format and voting time for your elections must follow what is outlined in your local Aerie or Auxiliary by-laws. All current officers will remain in their respective offices until your successor is duly elected and installed.

We've also received many questions and concerns regarding upcoming dues. The Grand Aerie has made the decision to cover the cost of the first dues reminder that is being sent out to all members who still have yet to renew. Local Aeries and Auxiliaries will NOT be charged anything for the first reminders.

At this point, the Grand Aerie remains committed to the [May 31](#) dues deadline, with a 30 day grace period extending until [June 30](#), and we will continue to monitor the situation in the coming weeks as things progress.

Lastly, we've heard from many people about the various small business loans being offered on the state and federal level in the wake of this crisis. We want to remind everyone to follow the word of the Constitution and Statutes regarding obtaining any financial assistance as an Aerie or Auxiliary, which means you would need the approval of your membership.



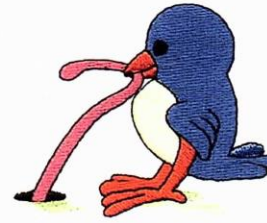

1. Be sure you have listed all your Officers, Trial Committee Members and other required Committee people in the MMS system.
  2. Check your Aerie By-Laws & House Rules. If more than 3 years old. Please have them reviewed and updated to meet your current needs (remember – all house rules & by-laws MUST also receive Grand Aerie approval before becoming effective)
  3. Make sure your Aerie has a current signed Affiliation Agreement completed and filed with the Grand Aerie.
  4. 990 and all required Federal, State & Local taxes are current including payroll.
  5. Property Taxes are paid & current
  6. Aerie has valid and ample Insurance coverage – copies sent to Grand Aerie as well.
  7. Small Games of Chance records are properly being maintained.
  8. Aerie is Incorporated & copy of Articles of Incorporation are forwarded to the Grand Aerie.
  9. All Per Capita (Grand Aerie & State Aerie) Taxes paid up to date & no delinquencies.

2. The tournament will consist of team, doubles, and singles events and will be handicap. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between entering average and 220. Handicap will be computed on a three (3) game series.
3. Entrants shall use their highest 2018-2019 season average of 21 or more games, unless current average at time of bowling is 10 pins or more higher, then current average must be used. Bowlers with no previous season average must use their current highest average at time of bowling ( 21 games or more ). Any bowler without an average must bowl scratch.
4. Averages submitted by bowlers winning prize money will be certified and any bowler found to have submitted an incorrect average will forfeit all prize money. Individual bowlers are responsible for submitting correct average to the team captain. Team captains should send proof of averages along with the entry form.
5. Any and all scoring protests must be made in writing to the tournament committee within 36 hours after bowling.
6. Multiple participation is permitted in all three events but a bowler may cash only once in singles and once in doubles with the same partner. Teams may cash more than once provided they have changed at least 2 bowlers. The first score in each event will be used for the all events score.
7. All prize money will be returned 100%. Prize money will be paid at a ratio of at least 1 in 8 in each event.
8. Tardy bowlers will start in the frame currently being bowled when they arrive. They will receive a zero ( 0 ) score for missed frames.

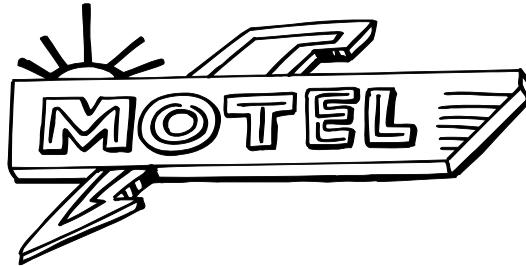
