Dear Brothers,

Once again, there were no visitations or Aerie functions last month. It makes it difficult to come-up with interesting things to tell you.

SMP Pat Rodríguez and I hope that you are able to come to our Testimonial Banquet on April 17, in New Kensington. We will both be presenting partial grants to our State Charities.

One of the many pleasures that come with being your State Worthy President is being charged with choosing the recipients for the three governmental awards.

Christopher Soff will be receiving the Maury Splain Mayor's Award. He served on the Crawford Central School Board from 1993 to 1997. He then was on the City Council of Meadville from 2006 until 2010. From 2010 until 2016 he served as the Mayor of the City of Meadville. Currently, he is a Crawford County Commissioner.

I am awarding both Cheryl and Francis Weiderspahn, Jr., husband and wife, the Anthony Angelo Municipal Award. Both were former 4-Hers, at the top of their high school classes. By the time they married in 1977, they were already serving in the Townville Lions Club. They also served in their local Evangelical Free Church as Sunday School teachers and Youth Directors. Francis served as Elder, Trustee, Financial Secretary, Pastoral Search Committee and Church Moderator. Francis has also served in many Agricultural organizations and committees; he was inducted to the Ag Hall of Fame in 2016. Cheryl was awarded the coveted Four-Star Homemaker Award in 1992, an intense competition at the Crawford County Fair. She has written two books, many magazine articles and appeared on numerous sewing TV shows. Fran ran for Crawford County Commissioner, running on the slogan, "A Public Servant, Not A Politician." Now in his third term as a Crawford County Commissioner, he has served as chairman of that board for 8 years. While commissioner he is serving as a Director on the Northwest PA Regional Planning Commission; member of the FCCA Board; member of the PennSoil RC&D Board; member of the Oil Region Heritage Advisory Board; CCAP State Human Services Committee and the CCAP State Agriculture Committee as a member and Vice Chairman. In 2018 Francis graduated from CCAP's Academy for Excellence program for county commissioners. Cheryl was voted Crawford County Republican Woman of the Year in 2015 and Francis was voted Republican Man of the Year in 2017 for their dedicated service to the local Republican Party. Most recently, Cheryl's skills were implemented to mobilize over 150 sewists in a mask-making movement. COVID-19 left area first responders and medical personnel unprepared and without the necessary cloth masks until Cheryl's "Mask Sewing Warriors" sewed and donated over 40,000 masks in just a few months!

Pennsylvania State Representative Brian Sims will receive the David L. Lawrence Legislative Award. Brian's 182nd district is in the Philadelphia County area. He is the former staff counsel for policy and planning at the Philadelphia Bar Association. Before his time at the Bar Association, he practiced law as a disability attorney representing disabled professionals. He also worked as the senior law clerk at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Washington office. Rep.
