Next stop was Carlisle for Eastern Regional Conference. Finally a place close to home. Only about 45 minutes from home. Debbie did a great meeting,

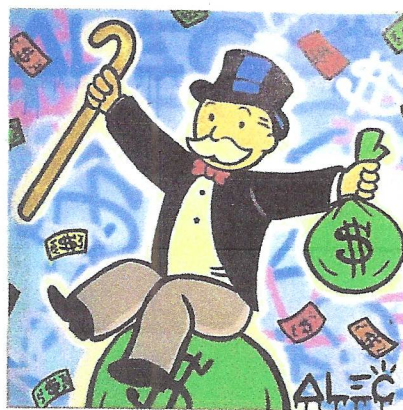
Now we are starting to slow down for a while. Hope to see you along the Eagle trail.

Hello sisters,

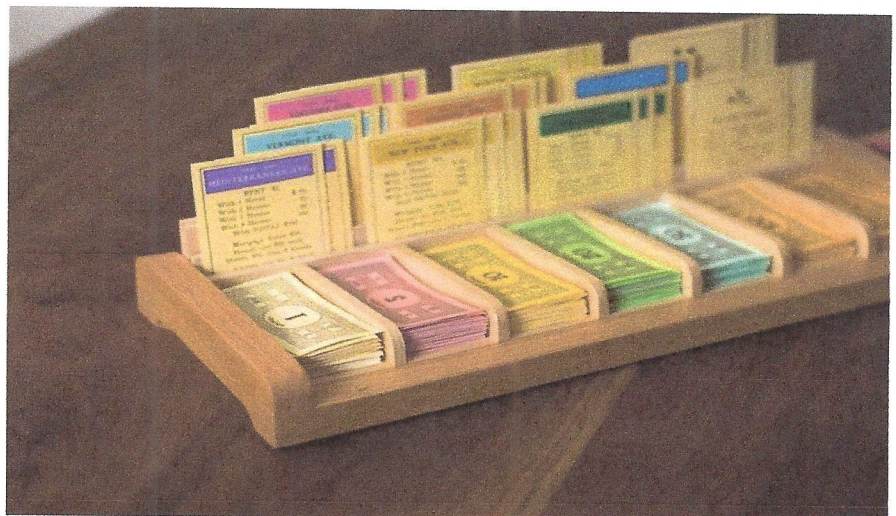

## CREAM PUFF CAKE

½ CUP BUTTER

1 CUP WATER

1 TBSP SUGAR

1 CUP FLOUR

4 EGGS

2 ½ CUP COLD MILK

1 8OZ CREAM CHEESE, SOFTENED

2 PKG VANILLA INSTANT PUDDING

1 TUB COOL WHIP WHIPPED TOPPING

HEAT OVEN TO 400

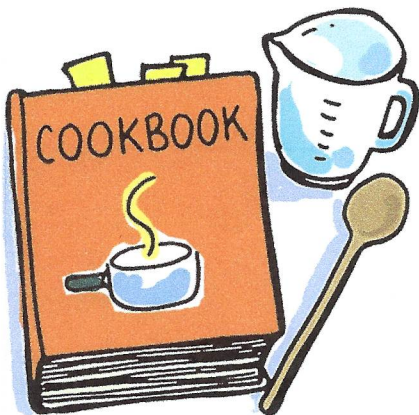
BRING BUTTER, WATER, AND SUGAR TO A BOIL IN MEDIUM SAUCEPAN, STIRRING OCCASIONALLY. ADD FLOUR; COOK AND STIR 3 MIN. OR UNTIL MIXTURE FORMS A BALL. SPOON INTO LARGE BOWL.

ADD EGGS 1 AT A TIME, BEATING WITH MIXER AFTER EACH ONE. SPREAD ONTO BOTTOM OF 13X9 INCH BAKING SHEET SPRAYED WITH COOKING SPRAY.

BAKE 32 TO 37 MIN. OR UNTIL GOLDEN BROWN. (DOUGH WILL PUFF UP ALONG SIDES OF BAKING SHEET). COOL COMPLETELY.

MEANWHILE, MIX CREAM CHEESE AND MILK IN MEDIUM BOWL UNTIL BLENDED. ADD PUDDING MIXES, BEAT 2 MIN.

SPREAD PUDDING MIXTURE OVER COOLED CREAM PUFF CRUST AND TOP WITH COOL WHIP.
