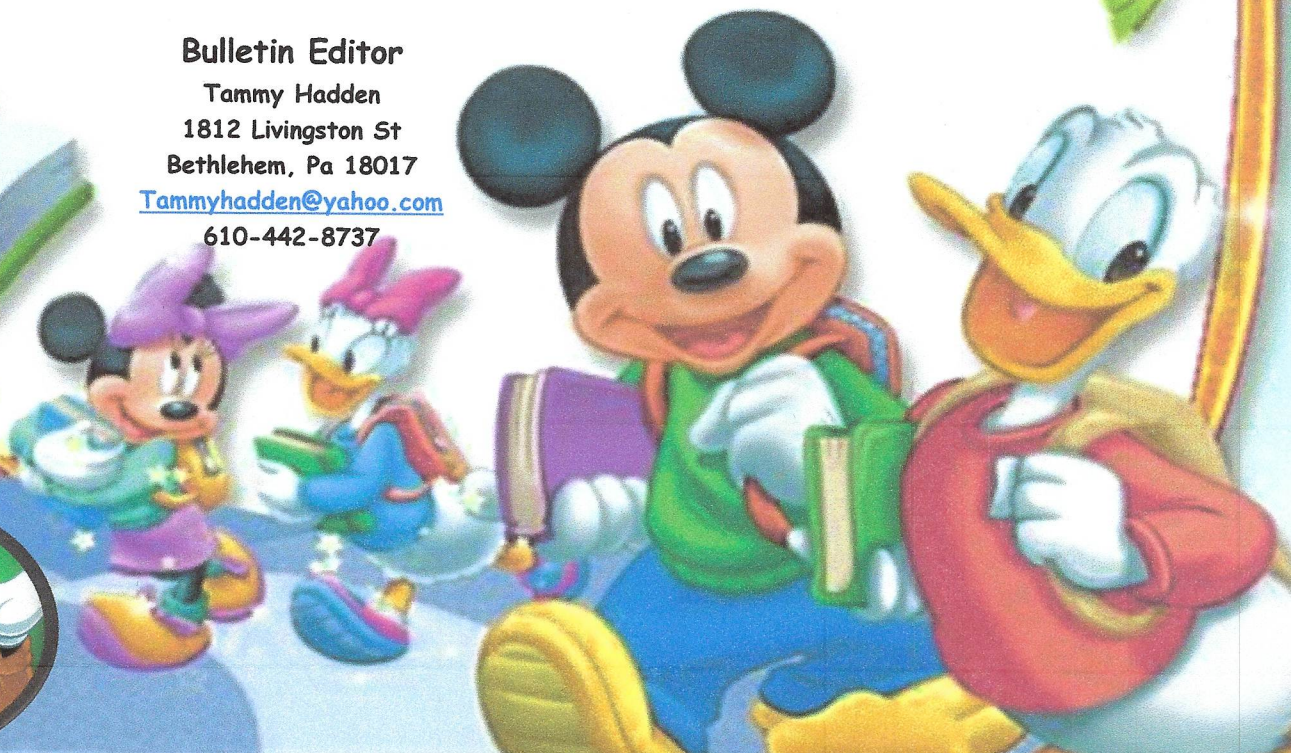
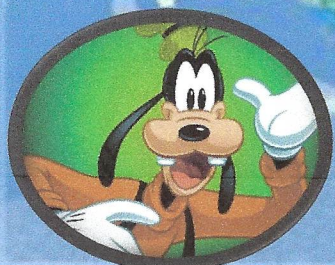

Genie and I headed home on August 5th, it was a great week. Met a lot of sisters and brothers and also learned a lot

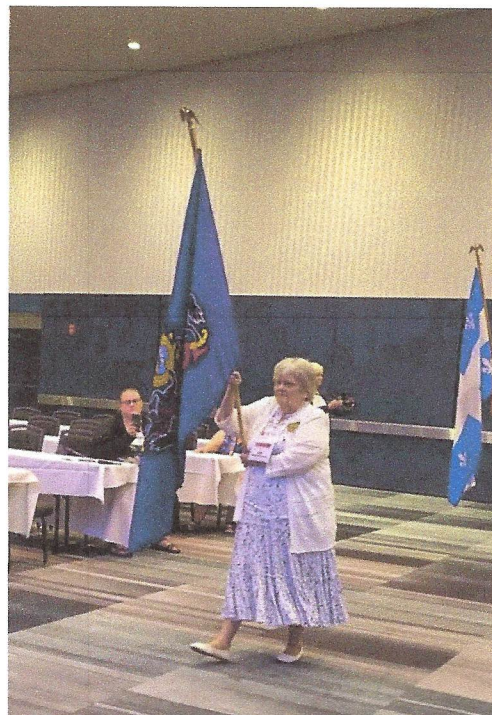

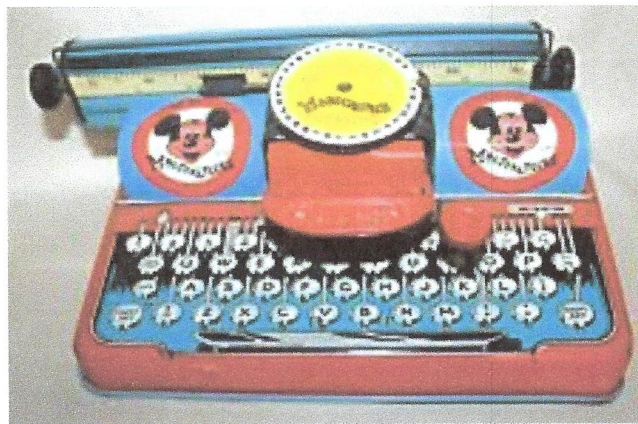
Thanks to everyone that sent me their payment for the Per Capita tax.
