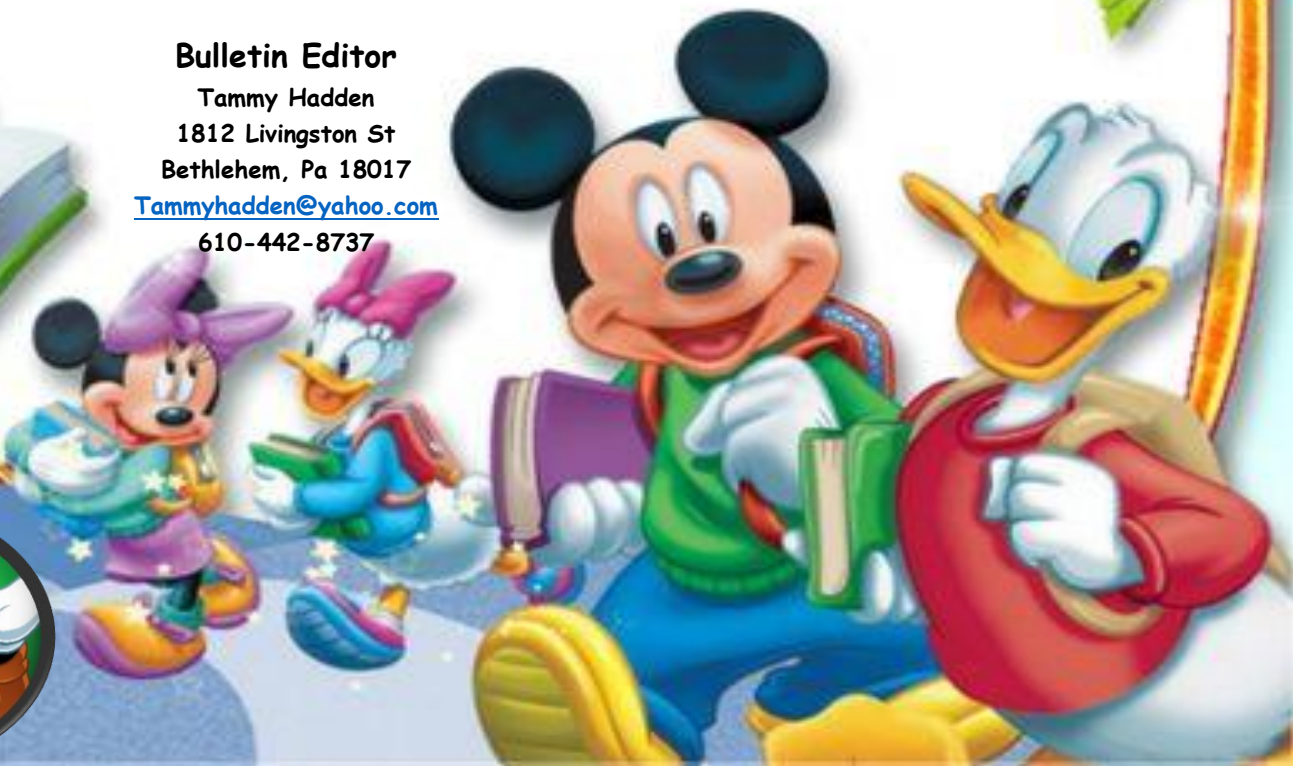

I received personal gifts and a donation to my charity

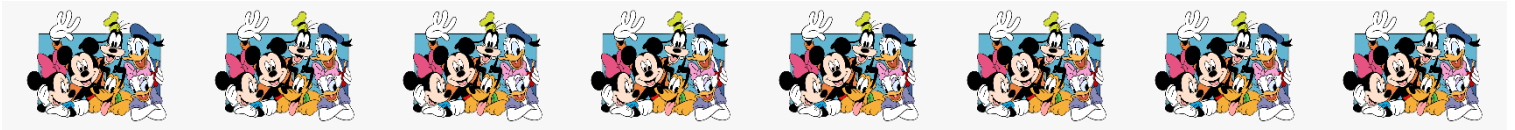
All three Section Captains had a wonderful meeting.
