

PENNSYLVANIA STATE AUXILIARY SCRAP BOOK AND POSTER RULES

SCRAP BOOK

- 1. 20 POINTS Page one must contain a picture of your local auxiliary president or district Director, two pages of your book to contain pictures of all your local or district officers and at least one line with some information concerning each individual, depending on whomever is making the book.
- 2. 20 POINTS Originality of Scrap Book Cover and/or Binder.
- 3. 20 POINTS Programs, pictures and newspaper clippings of auxiliary or district, charity projects, activities at meetings and membership promotion.
- 4. 10 POINTS There are to be no blank pages and each page is to be neatly spaced.
- 5. 10 POINTS At the Top of each page there must be a caption and also a caption underneath each picture of the names of people and/or places in each picture.
- 6. 10 POINTS District scrapbook must contain one page with material from each auxiliary. (If pictures of Aerie officers are unavailable there will be nothing taken from these points.)
- 7. 5 POINTS Correct word spelling
- 8. 5 POINTS Picture of District or Auxiliary Mother and Caption

POSTER

- AUXILIARY 1. Must have Pennsylvania State Auxiliary Theme ONLY.
- **DISTRICT** 2. Must have combination of the Grand Madam President's theme and the Pennsylvania State Auxiliary theme.
 - 3. Posters will be judged at the annual Fall Membership Conference

4. Posters must have a sealed envelope attached to the back of the poster, containing the Auxiliary Name and Number or District Name and Number

5. Envelopes are not to be attached on the front of the poster.

6. Only the words (Auxiliary or District) are to be marked on the front of the envelope

NOMINATION FOR STATE OFFICER

If you have an Auxiliary Sister that would like to become a State Officer, please send a letter of recommendation stating her qualifications. A motion must be made at an Auxiliary meeting. It must have a second and must be carried by majority vote. The letter must be signed by the Madam President and the Madam Secretary over the SEAL of the Auxiliary. If the candidate is one of the above Officers the Vice President or one of the Trustees may sign the letter. The office of the Madam Outside Guard is filled by Nomination from the floor and must be accompanied by a nominating speech of no less than two (2) minutes and no more than five (5) minutes. The speech shall consist of qualifications and capabilities of the nominee. A delegate, PMP or a Ten- Year Secretary shall give the nominating speech. Members are not permitted to nominate from the floor. Letters should be sent to the PA. State Auxiliary Secretary.

To office of the Madam State Vice President and the Madam State President in the State Auxiliary the candidate must hold the rank of Past Madam President and/or ten-year Secretary and such candidate must be in good standing in her local auxiliary.

To be eligible for any other office in this State Auxiliary a candidate must have been an Officer for five (5) consecutive years in her local Auxiliary and such candidate must be in good standing in her local Auxiliary.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR INDUCTEES TO THE HALL OF FAME

- 1. Any Sister who has shown outstanding and exceptional devotion and loyalty by serving above and beyond what would be expected by this Sisterhood at the Local, District, or State level.
- 2. She does not have to be, or EVER have held ANY office.

The Committee may choose only ONE (1) Past State President per year. However, it is not required that they choose ANY if they so desire.

If she is deceased, she still can be recommended. However only one (1) DECEASED inductee can be chosen each year.

- 3. A motion must be made, seconded and passed at a regular meeting of her Auxiliary to recommend a Sister as an inductee.
- 4. A letter of recommendation, listing the Sister's qualifications, must be signed by the Madam President and the Madam Secretary, over the Auxiliary Seal.
- 5. Letters of recommendation must be in the hands of the Hall of Fame Chairman by the deadline date.
- 6. The deadline date will be published along with these guidelines in the Pennsylvania State Auxiliary bulletin.

For this year letters should be sent to the Chairman of the Hall of Fame Committee.

76th PENNSYLVANIA STATE AUXILIARY FOE TIPS AND NOTES STATE CONVENTION JUNE 2024

The Seventy-sixth annual convention of the Pennsylvania State Auxiliary will be held at the Double Tree by Hilton, Pittsburgh Pa. on June 6^{th} , 7^{th} and 8^{th} , 2024. The State Aerie and the State Auxiliary will be meeting at the same time and place.

ROOM RATES: \$135.00 plus tax..

REGISTRATION: Registration with a banquet ticket is \$48.00 Extra Banquet tickets \$43.00 and Registration without a banquet ticket is \$10.00.

PRAYER BREAKFAST: We will have a Joint Prayer Breakfast with the Pennsylvania State Aerie, again this year. It will be held on Friday morning, June 23rd at 8:00AM. Tickets must be purchased on a pre-registration basis. Tickets will not be sold at the convention. Price \$20.00.

MEMBERSHIP BANQUET: To be held Thursday, June 6th, at 6:00pm. Section Captains and District Directors are the guest of the PA State Auxiliary. If your District Director cannot attend the District Secretary may take her place. Any other District Officer, State Officer, Past State Presidents or any other member may attend by paying the cost of the dinner. Reservations are to be made with the State Secretary, Jeannie Tresslerl. Use form Enclosed. Once you have made the reservation and you find that you cannot attend, please call and cancel your reservation, as we will be billed for your dinner if you do not attend. You will only be able to cancel your meal a week before convention. There will be tickets this year that will be collected at the door. The cost of the banquet will be with the form to reserve your dinner that I'm sending to the Auxiliary Secretaries. I'm waiting to get the price from the hotel

MEMORIAL SERVICE: There will be a memorial service on Friday evening, June 7th at 7:00pm. Please send the names of your deceased members and designate whether they were a PMP or charter member. Please send these names in advance to Jeannie Tressler, State Secretary.

NOMINATION FOR STATE OFFICER: The Pennsylvania State Auxiliary is looking for qualified sisters who would like to become state officers. If you have an auxiliary sister that would like to become a state officer, please send a letter of recommendation stating her qualifications. This letter MUST be signed by the Madam President and Madam Secretary over the SEAL of the Auxiliary. If the candidate is one of the above, the Vice President or one of the trustees may sign the letter. The office of Madam Outside Guard is filled by Nomination from the floor, not by recommendation by the Nominating Committee. Nominations from the floor for this office or any other office must be accompanied by a nominating speech of no less than two minutes (2) and no more than five minutes (5). Such speech shall consist of qualifications and capabilities of the nominee. A delegate, a PMP or Ten Year Secretary shall give the nominating speech. Visitors are not permitted to nominate from the floor.

RESOLUTIONS: After adoption by your Auxiliary or District, please send two copies signed by the Auxiliary President and Secretary over the seal of the Auxiliary. These copies must be in the hands of the Madam State Secretary one week prior to the convention.

SCRAPBOOKS: These will be judged at the convention. The Scrapbook Chairman's room number will be at the registration desk. Please make arrangements with her to turn over your scrapbook for judging by the committee.

CHARITY GRANT REQUESTS: All grant requests are to be sent to Charity Chairperson Ida (Angel) Baysinger. The committee will meet at the State Convention, and the charity grants will be presented at the Membership Conference in September. Deadline for charity grants requests is April 15, 2024. Please mail them before the 15th because they must be received by the Charity Chairperson by that date or they will be considered late.

BULLETINS: Any one wishing to receive the State Membership Bulletin other than Auxiliary and District Secretaries, State Membership Director and Section Captains, please give the State Secretary \$10.00 to receive the bulletin for 2024-2025.
