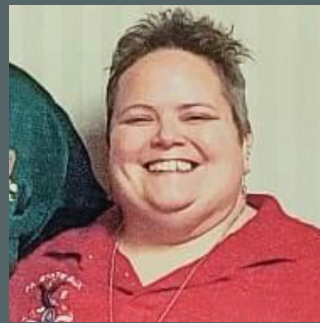

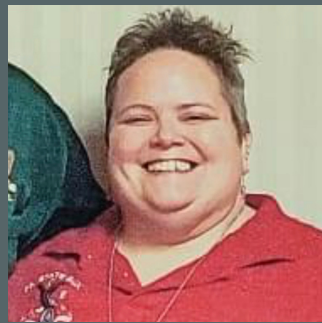

UNTIL RECENTLY, THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES LADIES AUXILIARY IN VERONA DIDN'T DO MUCH BESIDES SUPPORT THE MOSTLY-MALE AERIE, ACCORDING TO ITS PRESIDENT, LEE ANN TESTA. THERE WAS THE OCCASIONAL LUNCHEON AND MEMBERS PUT ON A CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS PARTY EACH YEAR, BUT THAT WAS ABOUT IT. ANNUAL FUNDRAISING TOTALS WERE USUALLY THREE FIGURES. THIS PAST YEAR, THE AUXILIARY RAISED MORE THAN \$10,000 FOR LOCAL VETERANS, FIRST RESPONDERS, SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS AND THE CLUB ITSELF. SPECIFICALLY, OAKMONT AND VERONA FIRE DEPARTMENTS, ROSEDALE FOOD PANTRY AND RIVERVIEW COMMUNITY ACTION CORP. RECEIVED \$1,000 EACH. THE GROUP ALSO COLLECTED PERSONAL CARE ITEMS AND CLOTHES AROUND CHRISTMAS TO DONATE TO HOMELESS VETERANS. PLUS, THEY CHECKED OFF THE WISH LISTS OF 30 RESIDENTS AT THE SOUTHWESTERN VETERANS' CENTER IN PITTSBURGH. ACCORDING TO TESTA, ALL OF THIS WAS MADE POSSIBLE BY THE AUXILIARY'S REJUVENATED MEMBERSHIP AND RENEWED FOCUS ON GIVING BACK. "THE LADIES AUXILIARY IS TRYING TO REINVENT OUR ORGANIZATION," TESTA SAID. "WE'RE NOT A BAR. ... WE'RE HERE TO HELP PEOPLE." TESTA ESTIMATES THAT FOUR TO FIVE WOMEN JOIN THE AUXILIARY EACH MONTH, FOR A TOTAL MEMBERSHIP OF ABOUT 240. TO JOIN, APPLICANTS MUST HAVE THE SUPPORT OF TWO CURRENT CLUB MEMBERS, PAY AN APPLICATION FEE, BE INTERVIEWED AND, FINALLY, UNDERGO INITIATION. KIM ELK, THE AUXILIARY'S SECRETARY, WENT THROUGH THIS PROCESS ABOUT FOUR YEARS AGO. AT THE TIME, SHE SAID, SHE JOINED FOR "SOCIAL REASONS" BUT QUICKLY BECAME ENGAGED IN THE CLUB'S SERVICE WORK. "AS I WAS ENTERING INTO RETIREMENT, I FOUND THAT INTERESTING TO BE ABLE TO USE SOME OF MY TIME TO MAKE AS DIRECT A CONTRIBUTION AS I COULD TO VERONA, OAKMONT AND THE VETERANS," ELK SAID. EXACT PLANS FOR 2024 ARE STILL IN THE WORKS, THOUGH THE AUXILIARY WILL HOST CHARITY BINGO ON FOUR SUNDAYS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. TESTA SAID THE CLUB ALSO WILL CONTINUE TO PRIORITIZE VETERANS, WHO SHE SAID "ARE A FORGOTTEN GROUP A LOT OF THE TIME." SHE HAS HER SIGHTS SET ON HOSTING A LUNCHEON FOR VETERANS THREE TIMES THIS YEAR INSTEAD OF ONE. THESE DAYS, THE AUXILIARY PLAYS A KEY ROLE AT THE VERONA CLUB, SAID SAL COLELLA, AERIE'S PRESIDENT. "THE LADIES AUXILIARY ACT AS BOUNDARY SPANNERS WITHIN THE ORGANIZATION," COLELLA SAID. "THEY TEAR DOWN SILO WALLS RESULTING IN STRONG COLLABORATION, COMMUNICATION AND CREATIVITY."

PENNSYLVANIA STATE AUXILIARY SCRAP BOOK AND POSTER RULES

SCRAP BOOK

1. 20 POINTS Page one must contain a picture of your local auxiliary president or district Director, two pages of your book to contain pictures of all your local or district officers and at least one line with some information concerning each individual, depending on whomever is making the book.
2. 20 POINTS Originality of Scrap Book Cover and/or Binder.
3. 20 POINTS Programs, pictures and newspaper clippings of auxiliary or district, charity projects, activities at meetings and membership promotion.
4. 10 POINTS There are to be no blank pages and each page is to be neatly spaced.
5. 10 POINTS At the Top of each page there must be a caption and also a caption underneath each picture of the names of people and/or places in each picture.
6. 10 POINTS District scrapbook must contain one page with material from each auxiliary. (If pictures of Aerie officers are unavailable there will be nothing taken from these points.)
7. 5 POINTS Correct word spelling
8. 5 POINTS Picture of District or Auxiliary Mother and Caption

POSTER

AUXILIARY

1. Must have Pennsylvania State Auxiliary Theme ONLY.

DISTRICT

2. Must have combination of the Grand Madam President's theme and the Pennsylvania State Auxiliary theme.
3. Posters will be judged at the annual Fall Membership Conference
4. Posters must have a sealed envelope attached to the back of the poster, containing the Auxiliary Name and Number or District Name and Number
5. Envelopes are not to be attached on the front of the poster.
6. Only the words (**Auxiliary** or **District**) are to be marked on the front of the envelope

NOMINATION FOR STATE OFFICER

If you have an Auxiliary Sister that would like to become a State Officer, please send a letter of recommendation stating her qualifications. A motion must be made at an Auxiliary meeting. It must have a second and must be carried by majority vote. The letter must be signed by the Madam President and the Madam Secretary over the SEAL of the Auxiliary. If the candidate is one of the above Officers the Vice President or one of the Trustees may sign the letter. The office of the Madam Outside Guard is filled by Nomination from the floor and must be accompanied by a nominating speech of no less than two (2) minutes and no more than five (5) minutes. The speech shall consist of qualifications and capabilities of the nominee. A delegate, PMP or a Ten- Year Secretary shall give the nominating speech. Members are not permitted to nominate from the floor. Letters should be sent to the PA. State Auxiliary Secretary.

To office of the Madam State Vice President and the Madam State President in the State Auxiliary the candidate must hold the rank of Past Madam President and/or ten-year Secretary and such candidate must be in good standing in her local auxiliary.

To be eligible for any other office in this State Auxiliary a candidate must have been an Officer for five (5) consecutive years in her local Auxiliary and such candidate must be in good standing in her local Auxiliary.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR INDUCTEES TO THE HALL OF FAME
