- **Reminder to all** – The Grand Aerie requires a copy of your **entire** Insurance Policies. Be sure you have fulfilled this requirement.
- **990'S** – Many Aeries are listed delinquent with your 990 tax form. If you have filed for an extension, you must send a copy of the acceptance letter from the IRS confirming the extension to the Grand Aerie. **Reminder** that if 3 consecutive years are not filed. The Internal Revenue Service **WILL REVOKE** your tax-exempt status and you will have to get those delinquent returns caught up and a 1024 filed to reinstate your tax exempt status. This process will be expensive as fines & fees will apply. As Officers of your Aerie, you are responsible to have all Federal, State, Local & Grand Aerie requirements current and up to date.

2024 F.O.E. STATE BOWLING TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This is a USBC moral sanctioned tournament. All bowlers must be a member of a Pennsylvania Aerie or Auxiliary of the Fraternal Order of Eagles and in good standings at the time of tournament bowling. Membership cards will be checked.
2. The tournament will consist of teams, doubles, and singles events and will be handicap. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between entering average and 220. Handicap will be computed on a three game series.
3. Entrants shall use their highest 2022-2023 season average of 21 or more games, unless current average at the time of bowling is 10 pins or more higher, then the current average must be used. Bowlers with no previous season average must use their current highest average at the time of (21 or more games). Any Bowler without an average must bowl scratch.
4. Averages submitted by bowlers winning prize money will be certified and any bowler found to have submitted an incorrect average will forfeit all prize money. Individual bowlers are responsible for submitting correct average to their team captain. Team captains should send proof of average along with the entry form.
5. Any and all scoring protests must be made in writing to the tournament committee within 36 hours after bowling.
6. Multiple participation is permitted in all three events, but a bowler may cash only once in singles, and once in doubles with the same partner. Teams may cash more than once provided they have changed at least 2 bowlers. The first scores in each event will be used for the all-events score.
7. All prize money will be returned 100%. Prize money will be paid at a ratio of at least 1 in 8 in each event.
8. Tardy bowlers will start in the frame currently being bowled when they arrive. They will receive a zero (0) score for missed frames.
9. Team captains must check in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled event time. All bowlers must have a current F.O.E. membership card.
10. All-events is optional. All-events entry fee must be paid before bowling in your first event. The all-events score will consist of your first bowled team, doubles, and singles scores including handicap.
11. Entry fees are non-refundable unless dates and times requested are not available. Total entry fees must accompany the entry form.
