- This is a USBC moral sanctioned tournament. All bowlers must be a member of a Pennsylvania Aerie
  or Auxiliary of the Fraternal Order of Eagles and in good standings at the time of tournament bowling.
  Membership cards will be checked.
- 2. The tournament will consist of teams, doubles, and singles events and will be handicap. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between entering average and 220. Handicap will be computed on a three game series.
- 3. Entrants shall use their highest 2022-2023 season average of 21 or more games, unless current average at the time of bowling is 10 pins or more higher, then the current average must be used. Bowlers with no previous season average must use their current highest average at the time of (21 or more games). Any Bowler without an average must bowl scratch.
- 4. Averages submitted by bowlers winning prize money will be certifies and any bowler found to have submitted an incorrect average will forfeit all prize money. Individual bowlers are responsible for submitting correct average to their team captain. Team captains should send proof of average along with the entry form.
- Any and all scoring protests must be made in writing to the tournament committee within 36 hours after bowling.


