Ronald McDonald House Charities®

In the early 2000's Ken Witt and Ken Spangler led a contingent of people that went to the Ronald McDonald House at Hershey Medical Center periodically to cook meals for people staying there. These people were the parents of children who were in the Hershey Medical Center. The Ronald McDonald House put them up for free. That is when they found out that the RMH saved aluminum tabs and sold them.

Ken Witt and Ken Spangler were periodically taking the tabs that the Carlisle Aerie and friends saved. When Ken Witt was no longer able to do this Ken Spangler and Bill Hershey continued to deliver the tabs to RMH. When Ken Spangler was no longer able to do this Mike and Sylvia Clepper have been doing this for the last few years. In September we took nine five gallon buckets to the RMH. Sometimes when we come home at night there will be bags of tabs on our side porch and Sylvia will say Bill Hershey was here.

The RMH has been saving tabs since 1996 and since then they have raised \$291,000 which equals 329 tons or 659,000 pounds or 923 million tabs.

IMPORTANT: These tabs are mostly found on soda and beer cans but they can also be found on some food cans. The aluminum tabs are silver and the metal are grey in color and will stick to a magnet. The aluminum tabs will not stick to a magnet.

I want to thank everyone who brings tabs into the Carlisle Aerie and Ken Yohn who makes sure that they get put in a closet until I get them to my shed at home. I also want to thank Eric and Carla Hoover and Tom and Christine Barnes from the Williamsport Aerie who have been saving these tabs for us for a few years. In September Sylvia and I took nine five gallon buckets to the RMH.

We would appreciate it if we could get more Aeries to save these tabs and when someone is coming our way drop them off at the Carlisle Aerie or reach out to Pa. State Office and arrangements can be made to pick them up.
