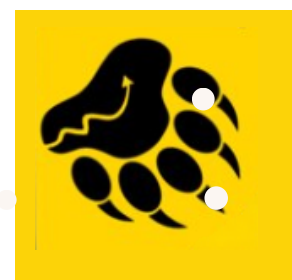

The per Capita tax for the Grand and the State Auxiliary are due now. Please enclose the per capita statement along with the check to me. Once again some Auxiliaries are paying the per capita out of the General Fund. The State per capita is to be paid out of the Benefit fund just as the Grand Aerie per capita tax is paid. Per Capital tax and funeral benefits are the only things that the Grand Aerie allows to be paid from the Benefit fund.

Also due are the Treasurer's report, the Audit and the 990. Be sure to put the Auxiliary's name and number on the copy of the 990 because sometimes it isn't on the form. You should mail everything in the same envelope and on the bottom left of the envelope put what is in the envelope. Treasurer's report, Audit and the 990. That way it will get to the correct department. You need to file all of these in order to be compliant with the Grand Aerie. The Grand Aerie also requires that the Madam Membership and the Auditor and the Conciliation committee be enter in the Auxiliary Officer list in the MMS.
