As a small business/fraternal organization serving our community, we are writing to urge you to support legislation that fairly regulates and taxes Pennsylvania Skill games.

The recent Pennsylvania Supreme Court decision has created significant uncertainty for thousands of small businesses and community organizations like ours that have relied on skill game revenue to help pay employees, cover rising operating costs, maintain our facilities, and continue serving our customers and members.

While we respect the Court's decision, it is important to recognize that the Court also made clear that setting public policy on this issue is the responsibility of the Pennsylvania General Assembly. Lawmakers now have the opportunity to provide a commonsense solution that protects small businesses while establishing reasonable oversight and generating meaningful tax revenue for the Commonwealth.

For years, Pennsylvania Skill games were found by multiple lower courts—including a unanimous Commonwealth Court decision—to be legal games of skill under existing law. The current uncertainty should not result in the loss of a vital source of supplemental income for more than 10,000 small businesses, veterans' organizations, fraternal clubs, and nonprofit groups across Pennsylvania.

We respectfully ask you to support bipartisan, bicameral legislation, including Senate Bill 1079 and House Bill 2213, which provide a balanced approach by establishing clear rules, creating a fair tax structure, and allowing responsible businesses like ours to continue benefiting from skill games.

Our business/organization is part of the fabric of this community. The revenue generated by skill games helps us keep our doors open, support local jobs, maintain our operations, and continue giving back to the people we serve.

Please stand with Pennsylvania's small businesses, veterans' organizations, and community groups by supporting fair regulation and taxation of skill games. We urge you to act quickly to provide certainty for thousands of employers and organizations that depend on this important source of revenue.

There were 13 changes to the Statutes that were passed by, the Delegates at the Grand Aerie Convention in Dallas this year. Secretaries, you should be receiving copies of all approved changes. Below are a few of the changes that were adopted by the Delegates.

1. Section 86.3 (a) The Treasurer shall keep such records, books and accounts, and make such reports as may be prescribed by the Grand Aerie. **The Treasurer's Annual Report must be sent to the Grand Aerie by August 1st of each year.**
2. Section 89.8: If the Aerie By-Laws provide, the Board of Trustees may, by written agreement approved by the Aerie, employ a Manager of the buffet and social rooms and properties of the Aerie, and delegate to said Manager such duties and authority as provided in such written agreement. The Manager so employed may or may not be a member of the Order. **This contract is to be reviewed annually.**
3. Section 89.9: It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Board of Trustees to see to it that the Aerie procures and maintains in full force at all times adequate insurance coverage against all losses to the Aerie, including public liability insurance coverage. The Auxiliary shall be named as an owner on said insurance at no expense to the Auxiliary, unless otherwise dictated by State Laws. **Each Local Aerie shall name the Grand Aerie and State/Provincial Aerie to which it is affiliated with as an additional insured in their liability insurance policy.**
4. Section 100.2 (a): The Grand Aerie encourages the use of Social Media to promote membership and activities, however several guidelines must be followed. If an Aerie engages in Social Media, the Aerie will appoint an Administrator. The administrator(s) shall be appointed by the Worthy President. This Committee shall give up their rights at the end of each year. A new Committee may be appointed at that time, or the new Worthy President may choose to re-appoint the current Committee. The Worthy President has the authority to remove any Administrator at any time.
5. Section 124.2: The Grand Aerie shall have a right of first refusal on all real estate owned by the Aerie. If the Aerie receives a bona fide offer to purchase, that the Aerie intends to accept, the Aerie shall send the written offer to the Grand Aerie Financial Adviser. The Grand Aerie shall have sixty (60) days from the date of receipt of the offer notice to notify the Aerie of the Grand Aerie's intent to purchase on identical terms.

Fraternal Order of Eagles 2026-2027 International Charity Make-A-Wish®

The 2026-2027 Grand Presidents John Boyd and Kim Haidsiak have both selected Make-A-Wish as their charity for the year. John has chosen myself, Pam Boyd, and Kim has chosen Leslie Franklin to serve as the Make-A-Wish Charity Chairmen for the year. We are thrilled to be raising money for them throughout the year. The Make-A-Wish Foundation is excited to see firsthand the power of People Helping People!

There are 2 key points to share that make this fundraising year a little different. First, money raised in your State will be used to help children in your State. You turn in your funds as normal to the FOE Charity Foundation at the Grand Aerie and the Grand Aerie staff will track the totals raised by each State.

Secondly, wishes will be granted this year as soon as funds are available, so we will not wait until the end of the fraternal year to make a mass donation. The office will handle all grants under the Grand Presidents name. These grants DO NOT require State Executive Board approval.

When we see totals for a State are nearing Wish fulfillment status, our Make-A-Wish liaison from the St. Louis Chapter will reach out to a chapter in that area to identify wish granting options. We will try to get several wish options for each State to choose from, however we will be prioritizing wishes that need immediate attention. We will only cover actual expenses for each wish, so each one will vary in cost compared to the normal standard Make-A-Wish total to sponsor a wish. If a State runs short on helping a wish, other fundraising done for John & Kim's year can be used to help complete those wishes.

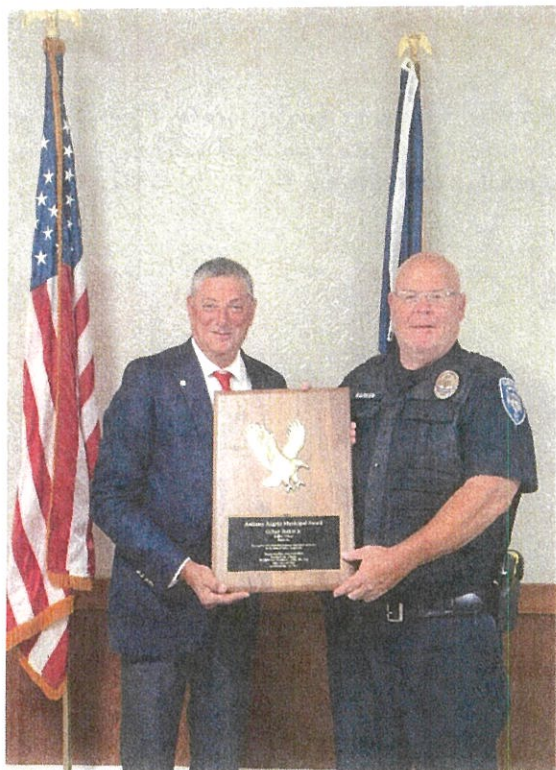
