



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### Legislative Update

Governor Shapiro recently referenced Pennsylvania Skill Games in his upcoming budget proposal, ensuring the conversation continues in Harrisburg. We support two key bills that provide clear regulation and structure for our industry: Rep. Danilo Burgos' HB 2046 in the House and Sen. Gene Yaw's SB 1079 in the Senate. The Burgos bill closely mirrors Senator Yaw's proposal and offers a balanced path forward.

This is also an election year. Gov. Shapiro is seeking reelection, all State Representatives are on the ballot, and half of the State Senate is up for election. Activity may seem quieter in the coming weeks as candidates gather petition signatures to appear on the ballot.

Separately, a major competitor recently pled guilty to illegal activities. Pace-O-Matic ended its relationship with that company more than seven years ago. We will continue advocating for fair legislation that protects Pennsylvania jobs and small businesses.







Limited partnerships, limited liability partnerships, business trusts, professional associations/domestic and foreign	Jan. 1 – Dec. 31

Failure to file an Annual Report will result in the administrative dissolution, termination or cancellation of the business registration and loss of name protection.
